Introduction


The compound used in this study is tryptic digest of human serum albumin.

Experimental

Column:	BioSuite C ₁₈ 3 μm PA-A (2.1 x 250 mm)
Eluent A:	0.1% Formic acid in water
Eluent B:	0.1% Formic in acetonitrile
Gradient:	0–40% B in 300 min
Flow rate:	0.16 mL/min
Injection volume:	0.2 mL/min
Temperature:	40 °C
Detection:	UV 220 nm
